

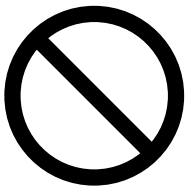
# PokerPlus Instructions

PokerPlus is played much like regular Poker. It can be adapted to any version of Poker and does not have a player limit.

PokerPlus is played like a regular game of Poker, with a few modifications:

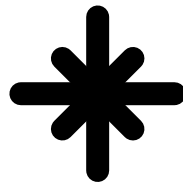
- Players are dealt 5 PowerPlays alongside their hand.
- After each opportunity for players to exchange cards, players are allowed to use their PowerPlays.
- Players may only use one PowerPlay at a time, and must take turns using them in clockwise order, starting from the dealer's left.

## The PowerPlays



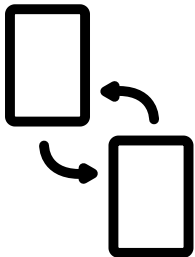
### Cancel

Played in response to an opponent's PowerPlay. Negates its effect. Can be played at any time.



### Forced Exchange

Force your opponent to exchange one card with the deck.



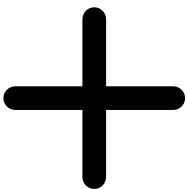
### Swap

Give one of your cards to an opponent. Pick one of your opponent's cards and take it.



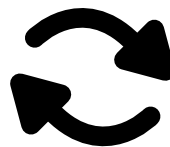
### Card Return

Exchange one card in your hand for a card that you previously discarded.



### Exchange

Exchange one card in your hand with the deck.



### Restart

Restart the current round (no new hands or PowerPlays are dealt).



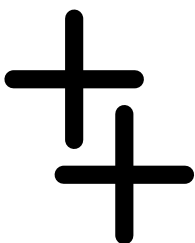
### Peek

Pick one card from your opponent's hand and look at it.



### Endgame

Ends the current round immediately. Cannot be canceled.



### Exchange 2

Exchange up to two cards in your hand with the deck.

Note: These rules are intentionally left ambiguous! Players are encouraged to remix them and make their own rules, just like Poker! Have fun!
